

STATEMENT OF ANTHONY E. JACKSON, ESQ.

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April 19, 1979

The Police Project's study on the use of deadly force by Philadelphia police reveals a pattern and practice of alleged shootings that are condoned by the police and city administration by the lack of disciplinary action against the offending officers. Nearly 50% of the shootings by Philadelphia police are in violation of Pennsylvania law in that those victims were not engaged in any forcible felony or threatening serious bodily harm to the officer or others.

Indeed, 75 persons were shot in the last nine years who not only where not engaged in a violent felony, but who were warned and running away at the time they were shot.

A critical issue discussed and debated in Philadelphia and throughout the nation is whether shootings should be authorized in circumstances involving the flight of a person who is suspected only of a property offense and who does not threaten injury to the officer or any other person. The issue is further inflamed with concerns about racially motivated shootings. In 1978, of those victims that can be identified 2 out of 3 were black.

The study analysis 469 shootings (60 juveniles) shootings by Philadelphia police from 1970 thru 1978. There were 162 deaths and 297 were wounded. Public concern over police shootings is seemingly aroused only in response to specific events, particularly when they lead to racial demonstrations (e.g., Cornell Warren, Winston Hood, Nelson Artist, Michael Sherard, etc.). Close scrutiny of disputed facts follow such events, with the backward-looking goal of assessing blame. Police issues regarding "when to kill" are almost never discussed.

Indeed, on April 17, 1979 when Commissioner Joseph O'Neil appeared at a hearing of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights he failed to answer crucial policy questions of when an officer might shoot. Stephen Horn, U.S.C.C.R. member, provided Commissioner O'Neil with a hypothetical situation, that essentially went as follows:

An officer comes upon a scene of an apparent crime where upon a shopkeeper runs out to the officer - and points to a man running down the street, and tells the officer that the man running is not displaying a weapon.
Question: Is the police officer permitted to shoot?

Commissioner O'Neil indicated that he would not answer the question because he needed more information. Mr. Horn suggested that an officer coming upon the scene may not have any additional information and must make a decision. The Commissioner again refused to answer stating that each case must be decided on its own. Accordingly, Mr. Horn observed that if the Police Commissioner failed to answer such a question, what is a street officer supposed to do.

The absence of policy discussion may be a direct result of the 'case-by-case pattern of public concern, rather than a pattern of concern over rates of shootings. When crime rates go up, for example, people often question police policy. If those same people were to monitor the police department's patterns

and practices of shootings, then perhaps police policies on deadly force might also become more subject to public review.

We note that there may be a difference of judgment about one shooting or another, however, our study discloses a pattern and practice of 50% of Philadelphia police shootings as being contrary to state law. Thus, we maintain that we have a deliberate policy permitting illegal shootings and that under the decision of the Court of Appeals for the eighth Circuit in Mattis v. Schnarr, 547 F.2d 1007 (1967), vacated on other grounds, such a policy violates the victims civil rights and is unconstitutional. That decision relied heavily upon our earlier Deadly Force Report issued in 1975. No law would authorize shooting a person under the circumstances of 50% of the victims, yet the Philadelphia Police Department, on the average of once every two weeks, shoots a citizen who is either engaged in no crime, or is charged with non-forcible felonies or misdemeanors.

In spite of the pattern and practice of illegal shootings the police and city administration have subjected only a few of its officers with disciplinary action of any kind. Clearly the lack of discipline serves to condone those shootings by police and illustrate a callous disregard for human life.

Leadership that takes swift and effective action against offending officers does not devastate the morale of the department, but, rather, it establishes

the moral-and legal standard of behavior expected by the citizens of Philadelphia. Thus efforts toward effective law enforcement should not and must not countenance such trade-offs of human life.

The study further reveals that in Philadelphia there is virtually no safeguards against the wanton and illegal use of deadly force by police. Denials by the police and city administration serve only to exacerbate efforts to control and correct this pervasive threat upon human life in the city of Philadelphia.

Testimony at the hearings of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights revealed that despite a 1973 enactment of a statute pertaining to the use of deadly force, the Police Department has not provided an interpretation of that statute for the guidance of the 8000 police officers.

Fortunately, the number of police officers involved in deadly force incidents (452) represent a small proportion of the total force. However, we note that 69 of these officers (26%) have been involved in multiple shooting incidents prompting the inquiry into the sincerity and efficacy of leadership and control by the city and Police administration.

The use of a firearm is perhaps the most serious act a police officer, will engage in. Thus it is imperative that he act not only within the boundaries of legal guidelines, good judgment and accepted practices, but that he also be

prepared by training leadership and direction to act wisely whenever using
a firearm in the course of his duties.

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Deadly Force:
Police Use of Firearms 1970-78

The Public Interest Law Center has reviewed and tabulated 469 incidents of Philadelphia police shootings in the nine years 1970-78 and 230 incidents during the four years 1975-78 since the last report on deadly force was published. These tabulations are based on newspaper reports which, for the most part, reflect the police department's account of the incidents, particularly in shootings resulting in death where witnesses were not present.

During both periods Philadelphia police shot a person on the average of once a week. See Table One for a summary. Appendix I contains a brief description of each shooting in chronological order.

This study reveals that more than 50% of the shootings were not necessary to apprehend a person engaged in a forcible felony or to protect the police officer from serious bodily harm. As such they violate the Pennsylvania law, found in 18 P.C.S. Section 508(A)(1)(ii), and the Policeman's Manual which states at page 64:

There are three instances in which a police officer may fire his revolver at another human.
They are:

1. To protect his own life, when it is in imminent danger.
2. To protect the life of another . . .

3. In an effort to prevent the Commission
of certain violent felonies or to prevent
the escape of a violent felon, but only
after all other means have been exhaust-
ed.

This is repeated at page 66:

Deadly force can only be used where the officer
knows the adult felon has committed a violent
crime and then only after all other reasonable
means have failed.

Nevertheless, during this period, of the 436 victims where it
could be determined the suspected criminal activity, 229 or 52.5%
were not involved in a forcible felony: 99 of these persons were not
reported to have been engaged in any crime at all; 31 had only charges
relating to the confrontation with the officer not involving threat of
serious bodily injury; and 99 were charged with non-forcible felonies
or misdemeanors. See Table Two.

Indeed, during the last nine years Philadelphia police have shot
75 persons who were not charged with a violent crime, and were un-
armed and were retreating from the officer when shot. Seventeen of
them died. This record continues today. Within the last four years
30 such persons (i.e., unarmed, retreating, charged with no crime)
were shot, of whom eight died. Last year, only 42% of the victims were
charged with violent felonies or threatening serious bodily harm to the
officer in accordance with Pennsylvania law. And of the 207 persons
constituting the 48 percent who were charged with violent felonies, it

is interesting to note that 38, or almost 20 percent, were unarmed at the time shot.

In contrast to the common stereotype, six out of ten persons shot by the police are not carrying guns and four out of ten persons shot are carrying no weapon of any kind. In the last four years 95 persons not reported to have a weapon were shot and 24 of them were killed. "Armed" means with a gun or any other weapon. Included in the category of armed was one person claimed to be armed with an artificial limb; another was a nude man with a tree limb. Twenty-five percent of the persons killed by Philadelphia police were not armed with a weapon of any kind. See Table 3.

Fully half of the persons shot by police are fleeing at the time shot and seemingly pose no threat to the officer. See Table 4.

Because of the importance and finality of death, it is worthwhile to look at the 23 persons killed by the police last year.

Eight persons killed were unarmed,* seven had guns, five had other weapons, and in three cases we could not determine whether the victim was armed. In the eight cases of unarmed persons killed, five were fleeing,** and so posed no threat to the officers. None of those eight unarmed

persons killed was suspected of committing a violent crime. Three were juveniles. In addition to the eight unarmed victims, two other persons shot and killed were not suspected of a forcible felony and were not confronting the police at the time they were shot.*

Race

The Law Center has been unable to obtain racial identification of shooting victims on a comprehensive basis. However, it has obtained racial identification of all but two of the persons killed in 1978. Two out of every three persons killed in 1978 were black or Hispanic, specifically 13 blacks, one Hispanic and 7 whites. The use of deadly force clearly has a disparate and discriminatory impact on minority persons.

Juveniles

Finally, in connection with the victims, it can be stated that 27 (11.7%) of the 230 persons shot in the last 4 years are clearly identifiable as juveniles, of whom 7 were killed. See Table 5.

Multiple Incidents

The study shows that most policemen never fire their guns, that a few are involved in a single shooting and that a very few are involved in multiple shootings. Just 13 officers on the entire force of 8,000 persons accounted for ten percent (47) of the shootings, and during the nine

years, only 452 used their guns. Sixty-seven officers who shot more than one person were responsible for 155 victims. Thirteen did so three or more times, including John Benham (6); Gary Davis (5); Robert Hurst (4); Thomas Rambo (4); and Charles Schalet (4). See Table 6.

The officers who use their guns more than once are concentrated in the special squads such as the "Granny" or stakeout squad, narcotics, Highway, Anti-Crime Teams, etc.* These squads, which constitute approximately 7 percent of the 8,000 man force, were responsible for 189 or 40.2% of the 469 shootings and for 30 (45%) of the 86 persons involved in multiple shootings. A special study of the 2 1/2 year period, January 1975 to July 1977, showed that officers assigned to 4 squads -- Anti-Crime Teams, Stakeout, Highway and Narcotics, were involved in 32% of the 149 shooting incidents during that period, although the Law Center estimates that in 1976 these squads accounted for only 525 officers or less than 7 percent of the police force.

Prior Complaints

Roughly half of the policemen involved in deadly force incidents

have previously had complaints filed against them or were involved in prior shootings. This is 3 1/2 times more frequent than for other members of the force.

Warning Shots

Despite a clear departmental regulation against a warning shot, since guns are to be used only as a last resort if actually necessary, 10 officers fired warning shots in connection with a shooting. See Table 7.

Off-Duty Officers

Off-duty officers were involved in 78 shooting incidents during the study period. See Table 8.

Location of Shootings

The report includes a breakdown of the number of incidents in each area of the City and in each police district. See Table 8A.

Departmental Discipline

There seems to be only 9 P.B.I. disciplinary hearings in connection with the deadly force incidents related in this report.* The P.B.I. dockets are skimpy with information, so that it is difficult to know what incident was the cause of the charges and unless the item is removed from the docket by waiver or by Commissioner's action the disposition is not publicly disclosed.** Only 4 of the 9 hearings believed to be in

connection with one of these deadly force incidents listed D.O.D. 5.18 "Flagrant misuse, handling or display of firearms" as one of the charges.

There seem to have been two 5.18 charges unrelated to incidents in this study in which the officer subsequently shot and killed persons.

Officer Daly, cited in 1973, killed Anthony Bennett in September 1974.

John Monaghan, cited for misuse of his gun in early 1972, subsequently shot a juvenile, Michael Gordon, in 1972, killed Karl Johnson in 1975 and wounded David Bussey in 1976. He was a member of the stakeout squad. Three other officers were also cited for 5.18 violations unrelated to shooting incidents in this report -- Flowers (1977), Jackson (1974) and Morris (1974).

Table 9 lists all of the officers identified in this study and includes all of their citations for P.B.I. hearings. It is highly indicative that 120 out of the 452 officers involved in shooting incidents have been before the P.B.I. at least once.

By contrast, the Department completely fails to discipline officers for firearm violations, such as use of warning shots, shooting at moving vehicles and excessive use of deadly force by shooting at fleeing persons not engaged in violent crime. There can be little doubt that this reflects deliberate policy. It clearly evidences a low regard for the human lives at stake. And in the opinion of the Eight Circuit Court of Appeals in Matis v. Schnarr, 547 F.2d 1007 (1976), such a policy violates the United

States Constitution. The Court there held that a state legislature could not authorize taking the life of a citizen not engaged in a violent felony or threatening serious bodily harm without violating the right to due process. It denies a person the due process of trial to which he is entitled and substitutes summary execution. The Pennsylvania Legislature has also rejected that policy by requiring that an officer believe a forcible felony to have occurred or there be danger of serious bodily injury. There is no evidence that the Department has attempted to enforce or carry this policy out, but has instead allowed each officer the freedom to set his or her own standard without regard to the law or the Police Manual.
