SCHEDULING ORDER: REVISIONS TO EXISTING SCHEDULING ORDERS

AND NOW, this 31st day of July, 2013, now that the evidentiary record in this matter is closed, it is **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Scheduling Orders III and IV are amended as set forth below:

Scheduling Order III is $\mathbf{AMENDED}^1$ as to post-trial briefs and post-trial practice in Paragraphs 5 and 6.

The last sentence of Paragraph 5 is revised as follows:

Post-trial briefs, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, together with full record citations in support, shall be filed within thirty (30) days of the close of the record.

Post-trial motions may be decided by a panel of the Court.
