Dear Justices:

Pursuant to the Court's January 22, 2018 and January 26, 2018 Orders in the above-referenced matter, I am delivering to you the following:

1. 8.5 x 11 copies of a map showing a proposed statewide Congressional districting plan (the "Plan") which we believe complies with the Court's order because, as you will see from the accompanying materials described below, it proposes districts that are compact, contiguous, equal in population and do not divide political subdivisions except where necessary to achieve equality of population.

2. A 2010 Census block equivalency and ESRI shape file expressing the Plan.
3. A compactness report.
4. A report detailing the number of counties split by each district in the Plan.
5. A report detailing the number of municipalities split by each district in the Plan.
6. A report detailing the number of precincts split by each district in the Plan.
7. Legal descriptions for each of the districts in the Plan prepared by the Legislative Data Processing Center.

The proposed districting plan that was filed with the Court on Friday, February 9, 2018 was filed by leaders of 2 of the 4 caucuses that comprise the Pennsylvania General Assembly, was not a plan either voted on or adopted by the rest of the General Assembly and does not represent legislative action by that body. I am delivering the enclosed materials as leader of the Democratic Caucus of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, one of the 4 constituent caucuses of the General Assembly.
