[PROPOSED] ORDER OF COURT

Upon consideration of Plaintiff-Intervenor's Notice of Motion and Motion for Intervention, the Declaration of Christopher M. McNerney and the exhibits attached thereto, the Court hereby GRANTS Plaintiff-Intervenor's Motion. [Plaintiff-Intervenor is permitted to intervene pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a)(1). Plaintiff-Intervenor is permitted to intervene pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a)(2). Plaintiff-Intervenor is permitted to intervene pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(b).]

It is hereby further ORDERED that Plaintiff-Intervenor shall have through [DATE] to file a Class Action Complaint in Intervention reflecting the intervention. The Class Action Complaint in Intervention will supersede the original Complaint such that this action thereafter shall proceed only as to those parties and claims listed in the Class Action Complaint in Intervention. A failure of the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission to join the Class Action Complaint in Intervention will result in its termination as a party.

Finally, it is ORDERED that the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunities Commission's Motion to Dismiss is DENIED AS MOOT.
